Confirmation Covenant

The Confirmation process is a journey in which the candidate will explore different aspects of the Catholic faith: prayer and liturgy, community life, church ministry, and service. The process necessitates a full commitment from the candidate, parents/guardians, sponsors, and fellow-parishioners as this is a sacrament that, by definition, makes the candidate a true witness of Christ, and more perfectly bound to the Church, spreading and defending the Catholic faith by word and deed.

As a candidate, to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation, I will

- approach my Confirmation journey with an open mind and an open heart;
- regularly participate in scheduled sessions with my parent and/or adult partner;
- faithfully attend the celebration of the weekend Mass and Holy Days, and receive the Sacrament of Eucharist to fortify and strengthen me during preparation;
- participate in the celebration of the Sacrament of Reconciliation at least once per year;
- be active in my prayer life, both thanking God and seeking His guidance, and learning by heart the prayers: The Lord's Prayer, Hail Mary, Glory Be, and the Apostle's Creed;
- prayerfully consider my role as a servant to others and complete 9 hours of service through Acts of Mercy, serving my family, parish, and local community;
- attend at least two retreats during my time of preparation;
- complete assignments as instructed.
